Review

Damn – this chick does it again – now please, I’m not being bias here cause we talk almost every day. I’m wondering if I would even talk to Emily if she couldn’t write?

I just have to say that I am addicted to Elle and J....fuck I’m addicted to all the characters in this story – it’s the grittiness that Emily writes with is what draws me in and hooks me – I first read this book as a proofreader so I don’t think I was able to get the whole “touchy feely” thing out of it – so I went back and read it again and fuck – I can only say that the relationship between Elle and J is nothing to mess around with.

Now, this one deals more with Elle’s world falling apart after that horrible cliffhanger Emily left us in Steel & Ice than it does with actual scenes between Elle and J – but what this book has is Elle – Elle front and center dealing with her heartbreak, her pain, her suffering and the shatters of her life. She is left picking up the pieces and going to war in her mind over the feelings she has for J.

Not only does she have to deal with that but there is also trouble brewing with her “kids” – this is where Elle’s character develops and grows into a responsible and loving motherly figure. J constantly talks about Elle’s “light” and for once – the reader can see and experience exactly what J does.

I think the major contribution Emily gives to this series is her character development of J and Elle – I know for a fact that this story just pops out in her head and wasn’t a complete thought when she started. So by knowing this, my hats off to you Emily for continuing to develop these characters effortlessly through each book in the series.

Take Elle for instance – in the beginning she can be compared to a robot – no feelings – selfish – all about herself. She fucks guys and leaves them – doesn’t want a relationship – only does friendship and even there she won’t get too close to anyone except her 2 friends – Chris and Aaron.

Then she starts volunteering at the center and spends more and more time with the kids and somehow these

kids bring out the emotions in her – her protectiveness, her giving, her happiness, her sadness – Elle FEELS again – even though she keeps telling herself that she is a shitty role model for these kids. Elle learns about putting others first before herself – she learns about sacrifice.

When she meets J – it may have started out as pure lust – but something is there – something pulling at her heart like it never did before and Elle learns to open up and trust again. She learns to love and by the end of Book #1 – she learns about pain. Now this book deals with all the emotions which are now open and lay bleeding out on a plate for all to see. Elle has to make the right choices in order to continue to survive and decide whether she has a future with J.

Recap

We pick up right after the major cliffhanger from Steel & Ice – Elle is in the hospital and is recovering – J is fighting to see her but Elle wants nothing to do with him. She is devastated at what she learned about him. This devastation continues and her life starts taking a turn for the worse – depression sets in and the only thing keeping her head above water is her “kids” from the center.

She is on a mission to try and make things right with Fernie – she learns about the love Fernie and Gen share even as teenagers and the pain and suffering these two are dealing with.

Elle also has to deal with Larry and his constant crushing on her – and add in Jose in that mix. Elle starts to learn just how loved she is and how many people are there to help put the pieces back together.

Then we have J who wants to put everything back together and get out of the mess he is in – so him and Elle can have a future together – he will DO ANYTHING to keep her safe and make her “his”!

Elle goes on a wild magic carpet ride in this book full with the cartel and bad ass bikers! The quote which really sums up this series is “I’ll love you till the sun ceases to shine.”

Oh....and on a side note here....if you do decide to give this series a shot...don't forget to include the 1/2 series also ---- these are told from J's POV and definitely add more story to the plot!!! Damn I love Emily!

This book continues from where Steel and Ice left off. We follow Elle as she recovers in hospital, we watch her struggle with what she is feeling and who she wants to see and who she doesn't. Elle awakes to Chris by her side, as the ever present best friend will always be. When J visits Elle sends him away, and reading this is hard for both of them. We can feel Elle's pain and you can see the hurt in J. "I was empty. Or at least I thought I was empty. J ran his hand over his face, catching a few tears before they could fall. As he turned and left the room, I realized I wasn't empty. In fact, I was overflowing."

This book centres around Elle's recovery, moving onto some kind of normal and "her cubs". We get to read the aftermath of the shooting and how it affected everyone not just Elle. We see the pain with Chris, Genesis, J and Fernie. We follow the fall out they all have because of this. Chris spends all her time trying to help Elle back into some kind of living state. Genesis has a secret to hold onto, which at 16 is a lot to handle. Fernie has the worst of all with what is happening because of what happened. He feels guilty over what happened to Elle, he is hurting because of Genesis and there is nothing that can be done. Elle tries to live some of the burden. "I was running on instinct, and my instinct said you had to live."

J crumbles, this is hard to read. We know that he feels the guilt of what happened, whether it was an accident or not. The person he loves he hurt. We read Elle struggle with how she feels, she wants to hate him but she loves him. "Baby, I'll be the light for the both of us. Just promise me you'll let me. Promise me you'll give me a shot at redemption."

J doesn't appear for most of the book, but we do get to read about Jose, and we get to watch the friendship between the two of them grow. I loved Jose in this book, he is such a lovable character and if Elle's heart wasn't with J, I think that Jose would be a great fit for her.

Melted and shattered was different to the first book in the series as this was about Elle and about her finding herself and a way to live without J in her life. It was about her realising that the kids at the centre mean more to her than she knew, it was about her doing what she can to help those around her and what she can do to better herself.

The ending to this book, just left me wanting more. I need to know how J and Elle's story ends. Do they get the happy ever after they deserve or do the outside force have more sway. I need the answers. Well done Emily Eck on another great book in this series.
