After reading Xander, I'd been waiting for this book, and it may just be me cause I'm a little bias, but I had a hard time becoming invested in it. Let's get something straight...I love the series. My struggle was rooting for Jonny knowing that I am rooting for the *Black God*. It just seems so wrong in the grand scheme of things. I mean, who roots for the vamps, the bad guys, the ones killing humans? However, Jonny is definitely the lesser evil over another vamp taking over, and technically, not a bad guy by choice. Once I wrapped my head around the fact that I wasn't actually cheering for the vamps over the Guardians, I got more into the book. And though I love Damian, he was kinda a d!ck at one point and I empathized with Jonny.

And poor Jonny. The youngest Black God; not given much of a choice in ascending to that position when his sister was kidnapped and nearly killed by the last Black God, and Jonny had to kill him to save her. Before he could even get his arms wrapped around the fact that he now needs to lead a group of vamps, he partners with the other Gods to eliminate a common enemy, the Others. This war in turn leads to the decimation of a majority of his vamps. And then the latest hit? The remaining group splinters when Jonny decrees that a truce with the White God can be had if his people follow his new protocol that allows vamps to feed, but refrain from taking a human life. Not liking Jonny's direction, the old guard decide to follow someone who may just have a chance at taking Jonny's place as the Black God. To add to the complications, Jonny's ex is determined to seek her own retribution for the wrongs bestowed on her by Jonny. Ashley is no longer the quiet girl he once knew. Trained to be a fierce warrior by Xander himself, she takes it upon herself to defend humans by attacking the vamps preying on them. If that means hurting Jonny too? Bonus! Before you know it, their paths will cross again, and this time, neither will be able to walk away unscathed.

There was definitely a fine line between empathizing with Jonny, and wanting to smack him on the back of the head too. His methods, although in keeping with being the Black God, kept me from fully caring for him like the other Gods. I like a bad boy, just not one that kills innocent people. Even if it is to make a point. All in all, another good book by Lizzy Ford. If you like paranormal books, I definitely recommend this series.
