This is book 2 in the Destroy series, And while it would help to have read book 1, I didn't feel it was necessary. It just helps you understand what Reed went through, better.

Kate is one of Becca's best friends, and is harbouring a secret she thought she, and her twin Cameron, had escaped from. It all comes crashing down when that secret catches up with Kate and Kate needs help, but can she trust Reed, a detective? Or will she and Cam have to run, again?
