Also, there was a need for better editing. I think a good content edit would have tightened this story up considerably. The planet name was awful, Daeria. Every time I read it, in my head, I heard diarrhea. The idea that the human women would only come in batches of four, is a plot device that is screaming for bride stealing on a planet with no women.
