I was holding my breath when I started this one. I was less than thrilled with the first book in this new series, In His Eyes. I'd read a few of her earlier time travel western books and was most impressed. So it was kind of a bigger disappointment when I read In His Eyes.

In His Touch is good news/bad news. I liked it better than the first book but not as much as the other books. In this book, Cade has just been released from prison after serving five years for murder. The first thing he did was track down a young boy who'd been living in an orphanage. It isn't long before we learn that the young lad, Jonah, is Cade's son and his mother, and Indian woman and Cade's wife had been murdered and Cade sent to jail for killing the man who killed her.

He meets Laura, our heroine when he comes across her under attack on her farm. He helps her out and is injured in the process. She tends to him and we learn that she too has and equally sad history. Her husband and unborn child were killed and their barn burned down. She suffered a burn on half her body when she was trying to save him and is very self-conscious of the scars that are left. What is even worse and more isolating is the local towns people have been spreading awful rumors about her. So between these two situations she lives a lonely life. When she meets Cade and Jonah she is so ready to love again, but frightened at the same time. She's already lost so much.

And Cade has secrets. He is drawn to Laura but afraid to tell her who he really is most especially after he gains her trust and slowly convinces her that her scars don't detract from the person that she is.

This isn't a bad book and as I said I liked it better than the first book. But I prefer Ms. Henderson's time travel books much better. There was the occasional ain't by the hero to prove that he's a cowboy from the west, but as in the last book it was more distracting than anything else. I'm on the fence about continuing with this series but I do have another older series I can read to help me see if I should give her more chances.

I'm not really quite sure where to start in reviewing this second book in Peggy Henderson's Blemished Brides series. There is just so much to like about the story!

First we have Cade, the gorgeous leading man. Not since Lucas Walker in Teton Sunset has Peggy (in my opinion) produced such a smouldering, sexy hero. The last few years have been tough for Cade, and as a result he is somewhat damaged. He's returned to the town of Elk Lodge to seek revenge on the man who framed him for murder. An incident occurs and Cade's life is saved by Laura.

Laura is a wonderful heroine, who is also damaged and hurting. A year before this story takes place she lost her husband in a traumatic way, but she is still determined to live out his dream of running a small horse ranch. Despite the difficulties she faces on many sides she has kept the farm going.

And the third character is a cute little boy called Jonah. He's spent virtually all his short life in an orphanage run by nuns, and is in desperate need of love, affection and parental care.

Watching the growing relationships between these three, and seeing how they all help each other to heal and blossom, is beautiful to read. The attraction between Cade and Laura (certainly from Cade's side) is quite intense. Peggy has written it so well, and it's just the reason most of us love to read romance novels... Swoon, swoon!

The book focuses quite a bit on the developing relationship between Laura and Cade, but, of course, there is more to the story than that alone. The first few chapters throw up a lot of questions that the reader wants answered. During the course of the book all those answers are revealed. And there is at least one big surprise on the way - a plot twist I really didn't see coming.

I also felt that I had the added bonus of learning something new about an element of American history. Although I love reading a good story, if I can find out something new and interesting in the course of doing so, that's even better.

So hats off to Peggy for another great book, and for providing me with a new book boyfriend to enjoy ;)
