Well, here we are, the end of the Saga. (We don't have a huge chunk of the end of the second book repeated at the beginning of "Surrender," which I appreciate.) Some things were resolved, some things weren't, and while the series was good overall, I can't say it was my favorite of MS Parker's work. Frankly, it doesn't live up to her usual stellar offerings. I'd hoped that by the third and final installment, things that appeared to be plot holes would be proven instead to be ingenious plot devices, but I was still left with questions:

What happened with the case of the woman who died at the beginning of the first book? There was something really strange about her death, and the way it was portrayed, I honestly thought that it was in some way related to Maya's time traveling, but apparently this wasn't the case. Other than to tarnish Glenn's reputation, the death seemed to serve no purpose, other than as a plot devise, and the murder mystery feel of the first book was completely abandoned. Very disappointing.

Once again, the private investigators Glenn hired in the first book don't show up. The brother and sister duo hint at some kind of paranormal ability and are really interesting, but end up being another truncated plot point that literally goes nowhere. Glenn pinned his hopes on them to find Maya, but by the beginning of "Chasing Temptation," three years later, there's only a passing reference to the PI's. I suppose that's better than not mentioning them at all.

The Civil Rights Era theme that emerged in "Chasing Temptation" returns in "Surrender" which I liked, but it's less about history, per say, and more an opportunity to use the 1965 Watts Riots as a plot device. In fact, now that I think about it, through most of the book, I struggled with the idea that Maya had returned to the past three years later than she had left, even though she had only been in the present for about three months. Perhaps it was to use this historic moment to build the story around? But if so, why not have all three books take place in 1965?

What the heck is with the quick ending? Why did Maya wake up the way she did and insist on doing what she did? It didn't jive with anything else in the entire book, no matter how long or how hard I thought about it. In time travel, usually the character needs to close the loop somehow, or their future (or past) self won't do the thing that must be done in order for everything to fall into place, like dominoes, in order for the desired result to occur. But Maya's actions don't work with this trope at all.

Despite these questions and plot holes, Glenn acted fairly predictable and consistently. He's kind of a jerk in "Surrender," but wouldn't you? Glenn and Florence are the strongest, most consistent characters throughout the series. They firmly belong in their time; they ground the reader in 1962/1965, even when we're reading a chapter written from Maya's point of view. Supporting characters of the era are also interesting, but the plot just doesn't hold up for me, which makes me sad. MS Parker is a truly outstanding author from whom I eagerly await each new release, and I get the feeling that there could have been so much more depth to this story. The only reason I rate it so highly, is for the character development and consistency of Glenn, Florence, and the supporting cast. Certainly not Maya, and not the frustrating (yet tantalizing) red herrings, unanswered questions, and swift ending.
