If he wears his rubber fins (voice 1)

Piggy Pie Po swims and swims. (voice 2 as performer 1 leads group in swimming motions).

When he wears his yellow coat (voice 1)

Piggy Pie Po likes to boat. (voice 2 as performer 1 leads the group in singing the action song "Row, row, row your boat").

And so forth. We find that doing lots of actions helps keep the group focused (we'll often have fifty or more children attend) and action songs help keep the performance energized. By the way, the bigger the group, the better!
