I did have a few issues with this one. The narrative in AGLM was overwrought, full of exclamation points, overused words and phrases, and repetitive in the extreme. The funny scenes carried on way too long and what had been a funny joke to begin with quickly became just cringe worthy.

If you are looking for mental cotton candy, this is the book for you. It's sweet, chirpy, and there is no angst at all. Sometimes one needs that kind of book in hand.
