Karma's a Witch is book 3 of the Karma's Witch series. Note that the first three books are offered free but the rest of the series will set you back by £10.50. Do I think it is worth it? NO! If you get the rest of the series under Kindle Unlimited because the series is mildly entertaining then it is ok. The stories are very short, so, if you are paying, then it is a rip-off. Note to editors and authors. As a reader, I feel cheated by the length of some of the "books".

Karma's Witches is the story of Topaz, the last of the triplets. Like in Amber's story, her character is

superficial. It is up to the reader to find the depth of her. I do not mind usually as I do not like to be spoon fed as a reader but the writing made her simply annoying when she should be gusty. Most of the dialogues in that book could be scrapped and replaced by something more substantial. The quibbling between her and Ryan is extremely repetitive and most of the time has no foundation and very futile.

I also dislike the word 'spaz' (for spastic). Writers should have a little more consideration for their readers. Other terms could have been use.

I will go on with the story because the next books are written by Elizabeth Reeves and Hope Welsh. So, I will give the series a chance.
