The story is nicely complex with plenty of twists although some were a little obvious from the outset (one character in particular was so obvious that I kept thinking they may be a red herring) although I did find both Fran and Libby irritating at times. I think I've developed a taste for my female leads to be slightly less wimpy than these two who seemed to constantly have to reassure themselves and each other about almost everything. Other than that this is a good traditional murder mystery that is perfect for whiling away a few hours curled up under the sofa blanket.

This book kept me interested during a day of atrocious wet and windy weather when outside seemed not at all attractive and the best thing to do was curl up with a book. The plot has lots of strands and I found myself suspecting almost everyone in turn before the end of the book.

I like Libby and Fran who are both apt to rush in where angels fear to tread and whose friendship doesn't always run smoothly. Both characters are developing as the series progresses and both have to deal with difficult decisions in their private lives. This is the fourth book in the series and while the books can be read as standalone novels I think it is better to read them in the order in which they were published.
