It's always interesting to see "after the action" and alternate universe takes of well-known characters. "One Shade of Gray" is a fun and funny unique continuance of Dorian Gray's story. Dorian is still arrogant, like he is in the Oscar Wilde novel, but he's got vulnerability too. When Dorian sees Izzy, his new theater producer, he's struck by her resemblance to his long-dead love. Convinced he's been given a second chance, he pursues

Izzy with a single-minded devotion. Except, Izzy isn't having any of it. She's not happy with her boss's attentions, even though she's incredibly attracted to him, and so Dorian needs to change his strategy if he's going to get his happily ever after. That's assuming something else doesn't go wrong.

I really enjoyed this book. Dorian and Izzy were great characters and there were some unique twists... including something I didn't see coming but looking back I can see the foreshadowing was there. The author's take on the stresses of living forever mirrors what actual scientists and psychologists think will happen to someone forced to live more than 120 years. To begin with, I've read neither of the other 'Gray' works out there that are so famous (for completely different, justified or rather unjustified reasons). But I know enough to get the references and hidden jibes in

this book. And anyway, I think it's best to view this story on its own because it's got it all: sizzling chemistry, conflict, emotional depth, believable characters, irresistible hero, interesting heroine, suspense with a dash of mystery.

I loved Dorian. I'm pretty sure I'd have fallen for him just like Izzy did. It's that mix of danger, dark past, brooding intensity, dominant streak and hidden weakness as well as oodles of charm. Had me hook, line and sinker, right from the start. As for Izzy, she's got spunk and she's smart. It was wonderful to see the shifting dynamics between them, with both of them taking charge at different times, sometimes even fluently shifting from dom to sub. One Shade of Gray by Monica Corwin is a unique twist on the Dorian Gray story that so many of us are familiar with. Izobel Vale is a young woman who works at a local theater in Paris. She loves her job and does well at it. Dorian Gray has developed a serious interest in her. In his mind she resembles one that he once loved and lost many years ago. He asks her to go out with him but she refuses on the basis on him being her employer. Despite this rebuff the attraction is there between them. Izzy expresses her own interest in him and they both begin the process of acting on that mutual attraction. When Izzy learns the truth about Dorian she finds it hard to believe. So she contacts her brother. He digs up some information and sends it to her but becomes more than a little concerned. Dorian and Izzy must work to discover the path that they will take in concern to their relationship.

One Shade of Gray is a unique story as it is a twist on the Dorian Gray story that most of us are familiar with. In this book Dorian is not a supernatural creature but just a "regular" human. He has found himself studied by the government in concern to his uniqueness. He hides it well and only discloses his secret to certain individuals that are few and far between. Izzy becomes one of those that he chooses to reveal his secret to. Izzy wants to keep things cut and dry – use him for pleasure and then keep on doing her job business as usual, no feelings attached. Dorian wants more but won't push to get what it is that he wants. On a level he knows that he should leave Izzy alone but he just really doesn't want to.

This is a unique take on Dorian Gray. I've seen the movie about Dorian Gray but not taken the time to read the book. This book goes up and down for me. It has its engaging moments and then it lulls and I start to lose interest. I find the interaction and back and forth between Izzy and Dorian to be interesting overall. Dorian gives off an alpha/dominant vibe but so does Izzy as well. When she tells him to back off from following her he backs off. It shows how that, even though he has lived for so long, he has learned more than a little healthy respect for not being a creeper.

I like how the author keeps him very human. He has his moments of weakness of where he himself needs to have the control taken from him and handed to another. There are elements to this story that I don't like though. When Izzy's brother just shows up and tells his sister what he's done it blows over too quickly for me. Up until that point for me the characters were true to reality for the most part. Eccentric millionaire has a thing for local theater director. He wishes to have a relationship with her but she just wants friends with benefits until things change. But for me, then the situation with her brother and her being so quick to let it go is just too out of place for the story. A more normal/believable reaction would for her to be furious with her brother and not speak to him for a good while at the very least.

I enjoy books by this author but this one doesn't rate as being a future favorite of mine. I did enjoy reading it

though. For me, when this story is engaging and on a roll then it's a good story and very enjoyable. I am rating this book 4 out of 5 stars. Overall it's well done and well written but I think in some areas it could have been a bit better. I look forward to reading more works by this author in the future.
