This is the second book in the Enclave series, and the first story that I've read by Jessica Lee. I was able to read this story without feeling lost. It's a paranormal romance about vampires who are willing to fight for what's right including protecting humans, so it has a lot of fighting. I will definitely be reading the first book in the series and am looking forward to more of her books.

Arran MacLain was a member of the Enclave. A group of vampire warriors who have promised to protect humans from Marguerite, the Enclave sire, and her rogue followers who want nothing more than to take over humanity any way they can, including destroying the Enclave. I enjoyed the first book in this series, Undying Destiny, and was pleased to get this one for review. We met Arran in book one as working partner to Marcus, who betrayed the Enclave. He feels he should have noticed something was wrong with Marcus, so has left the Enclave and spent the last two years trying to track down and kill him along with Marguerite, the Master who lured him away, and is frankly a real nasty piece of work. Oh I do love a good Bad female :)

At the same time human Enclave employee Elle is in town searching for her sister, who has been missing for three weeks. Elle and Arran have a brief, shared history, a single kiss that reduced Elle to a quivering wreck, before Arran then left suddenly. They're really attracted to each other, a gritty, internal longing that won't be suppressed, though Elle still wants an explanation for his sudden disappearance. However Arran feels he's not good enough for her because of his past actions, that she deserves better and he won't give in...so far anyway. Elle meets him in her search for her sister, when he spots her at the club he's been told Marcus frequents and sparks fly – in all ways!

There's some sultry, sensual, spicy sex between them, taking them two steps forward forward then one step back in relationship terms, with Arran being domineering and protective, saying it's too dangerous for her to be involved and Elle standing up to him, and arguing for her place in the search for her sister. Of course that brings them into contact with Marcus and the dangerous and mad Marguerite, and their survival is on a knife edge... They need more help, but Arran doesn't want to get the Enclave involved.

There's some good interludes with other vampires, extending the characters involved and when that happens I always wonder if some of these will show up in later books. I hope new vampire David does, given a second chance I think he'd make a good addition, as he seems a moral but practical person. Even big, tough vampires – in fact especially big, tough vampires need strong morals if they're to avoid going the Dark route and join the DEADs...and then of course there's Elle's sister – what's going to happen with her?

So – plenty of action – of the vampire violence kind, and not just the sensual and erotic action between Arran and Elle, and a good though simple storyline. This novel is a great follow on to the first one, and I enjoyed reading it. I have a preference for longer novels, that really mean the story can go in depth in the plots and characters, but I know many people like these shorter books. It's priced at £3.57 for 175 pages.

Undying Embrace is the second novel in the Jessica Lee-penned The Enclave series and picks up a couple of years after the events in the first novel. Arran MacLain left the Enclave to seek his own revenge on his former partner Markus Santini, who turned his back on his fellow warriors after being manipulated by Marguerite Devonshire, who he now serves as her commander. Arran has always had feelings for Gabrielle Stevens, who is on the search for her missing sister Alexandria, but he doesn't see himself as worthy of her, even though the feelings are very much mutual and Elle would love nothing more than for both of them to finally pursue something other than a working relationship. She also has the love of Logan (whose last name was never mentioned in the first or second books), another Enclave warrior and someone who has never hidden his dislike for Arran.

There were a number of things that came into play in this second book--Arran and Elle's love story, Markus's transformation, and the Enclave's ongoing mission against Marguerite and her minions. Everything tied together quite smoothly and there were certainly a few surprises that made the story even better than I would have expected (and my expectations were high). I liked Arran and Elle together, but my heart did break for Logan, especially near the end of the book. The whole thing with Markus was, well, frustratingly good because he's a character that still shows glimpses of the vampire he was prior to Marguerite sinking her claws (and fangs) into him, especially when it came to Alex, but there's no doubt that he's also become such a cold-blooded bastard so even though it's so easy to hate him, there are still lingering feelings of hope for the former warrior.

The Enclave is an irresistibly addictive paranormal romance series, one that will have you needing the next fix as soon as you've consumed the one before it. The characters are complex and there's certainly nothing ideal or perfect about them. There's nothing about Arran and Elle's story that makes it similar to that of Kenric St. James and Emily Ross's from book one, other than Elle and Emily were human. Yet, even with the different love stories, the tale of the Enclave and the cause they fight for is still very much there, along with Marguerite. However, there is a cliffhanger of sorts, one that involves an unexpected twist that had me all excited. And yes, as soon as I was done with book two, I went on to book three because there are just some things that can't come between me and the Enclave (like sleep). ^^ I loved Undying Embrace and give it five stars. ♥

Undying Embrace picks up two years after the end of Undying Destiny. Gabrielle is looking for her sister Alex who has been missing for the last few weeks. Her search leads her to a club that reeks vampires. The Enclave doesn't take kindly to traitors and Markus is definitely a traitor. After abandoning and betraying the Enclave to be with Marguerite, Markus has spent more than a year in hiding but his former partner, Aaran MacLain is still looking and for the first time in a long time, he has a lead. Aaran is ready to do his duty and once Markus and Marguerite are dead, he can (hopefully) return to the Enclave and his life. The only thing standing in his way is Gabrielle Stevens. Just what in hell is she doing in town?

Gabrielle Stevens has a few loves in her life, Aaran MacLain and her sister, Alex. Aaran has been gone for a year, and now, Alex is missing too. As one of the Enclave's most trusted human helpers (read: tech goddess!) Gabrielle knows when things are hinky and Alex's disappearance is definitely hinky. Finding her sister will take all of her skills plus some but she refuses to involve to the Enclave. Thank goodness Aaran MacLain left the Enclave ? While trolling Wicked Ways, a dangerous Goth club frequented by vampires, Alex runs into the one man she thought she would never see again, Aaran MacLain and he is so not happy to see her. Just what in hell is Aaran doing in town?

From the moment they reconnect, Aaran and Gabrielle have an intense sexual attraction to one another. Gabrielle is more than ready to give herself to Aaran but he is hesitant – in his head, not in his heart and body. When Gabrielle finally unloads the whole story on Aaran, he agrees to help her on the condition she stay out of harm's way. Yeah, like that's going to happen. Gabrielle is more than willing to do anything



necessary to get her sister back and once she makes that clear to Aaran, he has no choice but to allow her in and protect her. Let's hope he can get his body under control because every moment he is in contact with Gabrielle is one moment closer to losing all control and making her his for eternity. Aaran absolutely enjoys the thought of making Gabrielle his but his past is dark and ugly and he is certain once Gabrielle knows the full extent of his dirty deeds, she will want nothing to do with him.

Within just a few nights, Aaran and Gabrielle figure out their missions are overlapping and Gabrielle's worst nightmare comes true, Markus has her sister and she has been turned. Better than anyone, Aaran knows what Markus and Marguerite are capable of so taking them out has never been more important. With the clues he and Gabrielle have managed to gather, they know where to find the evil duo and are ready to go in guns blazing. Thankfully, Gabrielle has more than one suitor in the Enclave and before she and Aaran can launch their suicide mission, the rest of the crew shows up. Marguerite is bat-shit crazy and Markus is almost completely under her control so when the Enclave shows up it is quite literally a battle to the death. The Enclave intends to take no prisoners but Markus is devious and has a strong sense of self-preservation. To save his own skin, Markus has taken over Gabrielle's sister's mind and made her his puppet. In short, if he dies, so does she. Gabrielle isn't willing to sacrifice her sister and Aaran certainly isn't willing to sacrifice Gabrielle.

The Bottom Line: There was a spectacularly long time between my reading of this book and the first in the series, *Undying Destiny*. It was quite easy to fall back into the Enclave series and I immediately knew each of the characters and their drama. Aaran is such a strong character but he lets his past weigh him down and keep him from a truly happy future with both the Enclave and Gabrielle. Gabrielle is one stubborn and highly intelligent woman who, before her time with the Enclave suffered a horrible attack at the hands of a DEAD. She, better than most know what an out of control vampire can do and so, she does her best to save her sister without endangering anyone else. Gabrielle's stubbornness is matched only by Aaran's and when the chips are down, the two come together in order to save the other. Though I enjoyed Aaran and Gabrielle's story, there is a lot of ground covered in this read and I think that kept me from enjoying the overall read as much as I enjoyed Aaran and Gabrielle's story. With that being said, I'm not going to let one minor issue keep me from the rest of the series. I must know what becomes of Alex and Markus :)

Gabrielle ("Elle") wants to find her sister who's gone missing. She's left her comfortable home with the Enclave to go searching for her. It also gives her some time away from Logan, the vampire who wants to mate with her, because she needs to think about whether or not she wants him like that.
