The author includes a character listing along with a brief description of the Valdier series and world in the front of the book for any readers who may not already be familiar with her Valdier, Curizan, and Sarafin Series. The Dragonlings and the Magic Four-Leaf Clover story ended at the 50% location on my Kindle, so the story is approximately 85 pages, but the author has also included several bonus samples of her other work in the last half of the book.

I love, love, love the dragonlings! The dragonlings and friends are back as S.E. Smith once again charms her fans with another enthralling and imaginative Dragonlings of Valdier short story celebrating Saint Patrick's Day. In this delightfully entertaining tale, our precocious little mischief makers find themselves on yet another magical adventure when a wish goes awry and a magical shamrock sends them scrambling to save the day after their fathers disappear during an overnight camping trip, leaving them all alone in the forest.
