A 2.5 rounded down. My reaction to this book in conflicted. For the positives, I wasn't tempted to drop it. It definitely wasn't boring and it held my attention, and parts of it were enjoyable and/ or super creepy. I liked that it was a menage-romance-horror. How unique!

However, it has many glaring negatives. The biggest negative for me was that the characters and the relationship were grossly underdeveloped. I really don't know anything about any of the characters. I wasn't invested in them. They had little personality and zero back story. They were really underdeveloped. Worse, I have no clue why the main characters were drawn to each other (besides (not super developed) paranormal reasons). All they really did was yell, nag, and have sex with each other. Sure, we are told they are falling for each other, but there is absolutely no demonstration of that whatsoever. I didn't believe in them as a couple/ trio, and that seems like a pretty epic fail for a romance novel of any stripe. A romance with zero actual romance. Sigh.

Also, Alana's relationship with Tray was super odd. What the fuck is going on with those two? Friends don't do that with friends, and I found them (use your imagination) really gross and just plain unsettling and weird. Finally, there were editing errors that removed me from the story, and smacked of laziness. For example, Aiden and Noah's names were switched.

So, finding that special someone who doesn't mind a threesome with some sexy twins is apparently difficult. I scoff in disbelief, but hey, it's the premise. When she first comes to town, she only meets one twin and doesn't realize there's another. She goes on a date and actually sleeps with one, before meeting the second and she kisses him. Then she realizes they're twins and she thinks they're playing a game.
