After reading the first book in Forrest's A Shade of Vampire series several years ago, I joined millions of fellow readers worldwide and became a diehard fan and official Shaddict who now eagerly await each new release. This release is the eagerly anticipated second book in Forrest's A Shade of Dragon trilogy and she totally nailed it - again! The dragons of the Hearthlands were first introduced in Rose and Caleb's story, A Shade of Vampire 13: A Turn of Tides and became popular recurring secondary characters in the series. As a result of the mass popularity
