All Messed Up is the type of book that I wish would have never ended. I LOVED SO many things about this story.

Mallory, the heroine, was going to L.A. to see her parents. She needed a break from her job to do some serious thinking, because things were not going well at her work place. All she wants to be is a good daughter, one her parents could really be proud of. So, she books a flight to visit her parents to explain just what has been going on with her job and to get some much needed advice. Her job is VERY important to her but, at the moment it has her life, all messed up.

Joe, the hero, is on the same flight, he too is all messed up. He just found out the man who he thought was his father all is life, is in fact not his real father at all. He's on his way to L.A. to meet his real father, a man who has NO idea that he even fathered a child.

Mallory and Joe end up meeting when their flight has been delayed. It's not long afterwards when the sparks start flying between them. They end up having some very kinky foreplay while waiting in the airport for word on when their flight would take off. I'll tell you this, after reading that scene, I'll never think of an airport waiting area in quite the same way again. Things accelerate even more when the flight is canceled and they end up sharing a hotel room together. These two went at it all night long and let me tell you, they were so HOT together. I was ready to COMBUST after reading that scene! Yes, things happened rather quickly between them, but for me right from the get go, I could definitely feel the attraction they had for each other.
