Well, this was a pleasant surprise! I'd read Dex and was underwhelmed. But, the book didn't hit any major triggers, so I didn't completely write this author off and when DV hit my radar...I decided to give it a try.

I really liked it.

Axle is the enforcer for the Dark Saints MC. And not for a fluffy bunny MC, by the way. The DS's deal in drugs, women and forced protection for pay. Some of their businesses are legal, but not the big money makers. These men aren't the worst of the worst, but they don't let their conscience get in the way if something "unpleasant" needs to be done. And usually Axle's the one that has to "take care of it".

Maya is a sweet girl who fled an unhealthy environment in Michigan, enrolled in a college in Texas, and found a job at a popular bar on the docks to earn enough money to remain independent of her dysfunctional family(abusive father to her mother). But, the club that pays so well, is also run by a mafia family and protected by Axle's MC.

Before I move on to the romance, I'll just say I thought the main characters' pasts were the weakest aspect of the storyline for me.

In Maya's case, she **tells** us she's a natural caretaker. The extremity of this trait is what we're **told** ultimately made her a doormat for her family, taking over her life. But, we never *see* anything confirming this part of her personality beyond an internal thought when she wants to soothe a distressed Axle, (which I'd think anyone would want to do for someone they cared about) and fantasies about him being a dominate lover(b4 actual sex with him). She thought it'd be great for him to take charge in bed, allowing her to give over control/responsibility to someone else for once. BTW, at this point I was expecting some kind of BDSM/D/s sex, but no. Maya is not a shy virgin or apparently a submissive in the true sense of the word, and that never happens. Its only purpose was to try to convince me with another **telling** that she was always the giver and is tired of it.

Same holds true for Axle's past. We are **told** he had it rough growing up. We are **told** the MC saved his life and he'd be dead or in jail without them. We are **told** he was treated poorly in foster care. There are no real details of either. At least, not enough for me to do more than guess what led him to his killer role.

Maybe flashbacks of their childhoods would have helped me understand and sympathize with what they both went through and I would have felt...sorrier for them. Instead, I felt nothing for their past *suffering*. I wanted more.

Anyhoo...onto the good stuff.

Maya has witnessed a murder, Axle is assigned the job of killing Maya to cover it up. But, there's one small problem: Axle has already met, kissed and more importantly, liked Maya. They had an instant connection, and though they've only shared one kiss...it meant something to both of them. Now what's a badass enforcer, loyal to his club, supposed to do now?

The author did an awesome job of depicting Axle's inner turmoil. Love or duty? Doing what's right, or doing what's right for the Saints? The scene on the dunes was so well done I stayed up late because I had to know if he'd go through with it or not. (And yes, I KNOW this is a romance and the H really isn't going to kill the h, but it *felt* like he might!) Though it was Maya's heart, and ultimately her life on the line, I ended up feeling sorry for Axle! How crazy is that? Axle was so conflicted--who does he protect--the Club, or the innocent woman he's rapidly falling in love with?

It. Was. Delicious.

Why not 5 stars? Besides the lack of connection with their pasts and some editing issues, I thought Axle not asking for details of the murder and Maya not telling him exactly what happened was a bit far-fetched. Having no idea he's been assigned to kill her, why wouldn't she? She knows he's a member of the MC that runs the town, and even though the police told her not to talk about it, I think most people would be afraid enough to seek protection from someone powerful enough to help. By this point, she has slept with Axle and has feelings for him. I thought it took way too long for her to spill the beans. If she had, Axle would have had more ammunition to sway the club to back off Maya. I also hated the Saints for the decision to have Maya killed in the first place. Twice! But, it's okay, cuz they all felt bad about it. No. Just no. Oh, and for (view spoiler)

I liked this couple a lot. Maya wasn't a doormat or stupid, just a bit too trusting. And though it was pretty much insta/everything...when Axle fell, he fell hard.
