I love how L.B. Simmons gives us a slice of real life in her books along with the love story. In *Running on Empty* we got the story of a single mother of 3 young girls dealing with the loss of her husband coupled with the second chance fairytale. In *Recovery*, we get the big happy ever after moment and then are hit with what comes next...the REAL stuff. The merging of two households, parenting differences, unexpected changes, and just learning to be a couple and family under one roof. It is not always easy to fight the daily dramas and real life is not perfect. It is messy and frustrating as much as it is joyous and sweet.

I adored Blake in the first book and that did not change...in fact I think I love him even more in this one. He is sweet, loving, invested, and tries to step into his new role of husband and father figure as best he can. He is so good with the girls that it just made my heart melt. But he also needs to feel needed and sometimes Alex is so used to being in control that it is hard to take a helping hand. Alex is stubborn, used to doing things her own way, and being independent. And communication with new couples and families can be hard. So they struggle a bit to find their way in their new life together. The girls are adorable, hilarious, and full of mischief. And there is so much realism as to how life with kids really works. This novella was much, much better than the previous book. With *Running On Empty*, I felt like Alex didn't really learn how to be an adult, even with everything she'd been through. But with this story, she did.

*Recovery* starts pretty soon after *ROE* leaves off. Alex and Blake are adjusting to the married life. Like any couple, it has its ups and downs. Alex is especially having a hard time adjusting, since she's so used to doing things independently. However, here she actually matures and learns. She needs to have some people tell her that it's ok to not have to do everything and to be in control, but she finally gets it.

In the beginning she was pretty much the same as she was in *ROE*, but throughout the story she learned and matured and I really liked the person she became.

And thank you, Blake, for calling Alex out on her parenting. I saw it in *ROE* too, but I was more concerned with everything else that was going on to mention it. Blake tells her that it is **not** okay to let them do nothing around the house. +100 for Blake.

Blake also improved here. He learned to communicate and he learned how to adjust in the household. I really liked how Blake and Alex helped each other grow into the wonderful couple that they are at the end.

I really felt like this book was a huge improvement compared to ROE, and I'm so glad I gave it a chance. Both Alex and Blake acted like adults here and I was able to connect with them and fully understand their actions.

The plot was also very good. I liked that marriage wasn't portrayed as something that's all flowers and rainbows, and that you have to *work* for it. I also loved the ending—it was really, really sweet. I also really enjoyed that though it is a novella—and therefore short—it didn't feel like it was missing anything and the pace was just right.

I do recommend you read this one, because it's sweet and portrays marriage realistically and yet still manages to end with a happily ever after. You don't necessarily have to read ROE, but you'll be confused in the beginning because most of the characters were already introduced in the previous book.
