The sisters are going about their lives not knowing that a coven of warlocks are after them. Phoebe is taking Karate classes and meets a nice guy, which she hits it off with. Piper is going to start mentoring a girl named Celeste, but turns into her mentoring two girls. The second girl is named Daria.

Her sisters don't think it is a good idea that she does this though. Piper is not going to have any of it though and does it anyway. Prue has met a person in the Wicca like them Adrienne that owns a shop. Prue is starting to trust a little more, but she still is second guessing things.

There is only one huge problem with the sisters' new friends. One or more of them is going to be bad news. It takes them a while to figure out something is off. Prue about gets ran over by a SUV. Phoebe has a premonition that has the opposite affect and Piper is almost killed by a falling shelf of can goods at P3. The one thing that is in common is the red ribbon they all find right before the accidents.

Their powers have been reversed, instead of helping them their powers are working against them. A trip to the Book of Shadows reveals a coven of warlocks that are called The Coven of the New Sun. They have been around for a long time and have tried for their ancestors powers before. The red ribbon is their calling card.

The sisters find themselves trapped at the end. The coven members are revealed and it is a shock to them. Two members bit the dust, one completely forgets about the coven and Celeste the girl Piper was trying to help gets a fresh start.

I felt bad for Prue and if you read you will understand why. Phoebe's ending was heart breaking as well. As she says in the end sometimes love hurts, especially if you're a witch.
