Yes, it is about the sex, but for each couple I truly got a feel for their emotions, their wants and needs and not just the ones below the waist. The author really gets inside these characters head, not just their pants.

Historical erotic romance and historical smut of quality are a little hard to come across. *Wanton Wives* by Catherine Gayle, is a fair anthology of five stories of married women in the Regency era (not specified when exactly) who are unsatisfied with their love lives and set on improving it.

I got this as a freebie from amazon and didn't have many expectations since the uniqueness of the genre combined with the 0.00 \$ price didn't inspire me much, but I thought to give it a shot. Well, I was pleasantly surprised! The writing was decently solid, the sex scenes were graphic and well described and the plot of most out of the 5 stories was well developed. I enjoyed mostly the first one, the story of Judith and Piers that were married for four years without success in their love life and found it almost unexpectedly after a little nudge and another more adventurous try. All the stories were connected directly or indirectly to Lord Holbrook who played the part of the villain "catalyst" helping the progress of each story, and keeping his own, last but not best to close the anthology.

Overall, it's a fun read despite the lack in accuracy of the era's talk, vocabulary and customs and I don't regret keeping this specimen of historical smut in my kindle.
