I first read this book in the '90's when I was a teenager, as I was mad on all things alien related. (probably due to my love of the X Files at the time.) I remember that I quite enjoyed this book, although I couldn't remember too many of the details. When I had the chance to listen to the audiobook recently, I jumped at it (the chance, not the audiobook, because that's wierd now.) I still enjoyed the story and remembered more of it as the plot unfolded. The story focusses on a group of youngsters coming face to face with a bunch of aliens, who land in the kids' hometown of Spooksville.
