Ooooookay, als Archeus war nicht der Bösewicht der Serie, erkennt man recht schnell - v.a. wenn man auch sieht, dass dessen Geschichte bei Angel & Faith weitergeführt wird. Die dortigen Helden dürfen sich mit ihm weiter beschäftigen.

Dieser Band beginnt etwas irritierend mit einem Besuch bei Harmony, der Vorstellung, dass das Militär "wieder" mit magischen Kreaturen zusammenarbeitet um die aktuelle Krisensituation in den Griff zu bekommen. Man verlangt Treue und Lüge, die Scoobies lassen sich davon zwar nicht mehr aus dem Ruder bringen, aber die dadurch entstehenden Interessenskonflikte nehmen Einfluss. Parteien, Gruppen gründen sich und man findet am Ende einen Kompromiss, der für alle Beteiligten anscheinend gut sein dürfte. Buffy hat als einzige Bauchweh und man wird als Leser das Gefühl nicht los, dass hier mehr dahinter steckt.

Das Ende ist opulent inszeniert und mit einer Entscheidung verbunden, welche mit dem Ende mancher Fernsehstaffeln vergleichbar ist. Dramatisch und emotionell zugleich, hier ist noch einiges offen - damit sind die drei Sterne mit Bauchweh vergeben, weil gut erzählt, aber das Gesamtergebnis nicht ausreichend befriedigend wirkt, was bei solchen interimistisch angelegten Handlungssträngen sehr leicht passieren kann. Dieser kann nur wackelig auf eigenen Beinen bestehen, erscheint mehr wie eine Vorbereitung auf ein großes Finale.

The ramifications of the broken portal in the last volume come into play here, and new, unexpected alliances are forged. There's a lot of action here, and all of it feels justified, and very much in keeping with the story moving forward. Andrew especially gets a strong moment, and the relationship between Buffy and Spike gets some interesting testing (with the reappearance of a favorite minor character, and a face from the past that teases a trope but plays out much better than it threatened). And the last issue in this collection, which finally starts unraveling the big bad? I'm tempted to say 'masterful:' it plays out very well, turning what could have been a deus ex machina into compelling character growth. Parts of it have been teased the entire series, so it was good to see it come to its fruition. Just all around a strong collection.
