So when Belle announces her plans to move away to attend college, it forces a now or never situation between a young man and woman who are secretly head over heels for each other. With Belles desire to shed her virginity with the one man she wants the most and Jackson's yearning to have the one woman he never thought good enough for him, will one night be enough to help them say goodbye forever? She'd never had much luck with love, and she always took the fallout of her attempts hard. Everything they experience, feel and talk about is written in one of the most plausible ways I've ever known from an author. Not many have the talent to write characters who have the perfect balance of believability but still enough struggle to keep their story stimulating.

There are quite a few things going on during the story, sometimes that can make the story very muddled, but not in this instance. It kept me turning the pages to find out what happened.
