This is just a nice engagement of convenience story of a real estate tycoon hero and his personal assistant, single mom heroine. I say "nice" because both the H/h are good people - the hero might have a ruthless revenge planned against a "family man" resort owner - but once his reasons are revealed it makes a lot of sense. The heroine is no pushover - she enters the engagement of convenience to save the hero embarrassment - not because he dangled any financial inducements in front of her. In fact, the hero has to work around the heroine's ethics on many occasions.

The engagement of convenience turns into a romance and all is well until the hero actually achieves his revenge. I was disappointed in the heroine for being so judgmental of the hero, but she reflects after they

break up and realizes how priggish she sounded.

While healing and forgiveness isn't often shown on page in an HP, the resort owner actually asked the hero for forgiveness and admitted his guilt. That the hero didn't immediately let go of his anger and resentment was a nice realistic touch, I thought. He's still working on it in the epilogue and that was nice to see. The heroine was right about not carrying around all of those negative feelings - it's just hard to do in the moment and the author was understanding of this.

Give this one a try if you like this trope and your landscape peopled with characters who have good intentions.
