I bought the Sweet Life Boxed set, and this was one of the books included.

This book, to me, didn't seem well thought out. It was very confusing, and there were a lot of errors - grammatical and formatting - that really detracted from the story. It seemed to jump around a lot, and I didn't really get much of a romance vibe from the story. It's really more of a paranormal murder mystery than a romance. I guess, since the main characters are a couple on their honeymoon, that's the romantic element?

As far as the murder mystery element, I didn't really get it. The end seemed kind of thrown together, almost like we needed to blame someone so let's pick....eeny, meeny, miny, moe...you!
