Terelle had to be ready at any minute to take off work and go get Marquise. Finally the day came when he got to come home.

"He'd grown up in prison--matured. The things he used to do, he was no longer interested in doing. Terelle's mom Cassandra came over and accused Marquise of something shocking. Of course, Marquise denied it, but Terelle didn't know what to think.

Marquise started to get a little too comfortable at home and was going to start back at old habits, but Terelle wasn't going to let him.
