- There is not much of a plot, really. Dana, the heroine, wants to say goodbye to dating hot guys as they all turned out to be as*holes but she wants to f*ck one last guy who is very hot - "one for the road" (her words, not mine)

- She is so very infuriating and annoying with her silly inner monologues. She repeatedly calls herself a "ho" as she can't help herself have sex with any hot guy and then, she goes and classifies other people with her assumptions. It's taken me a lot longer than normal to read and it's frustrating when you're desperate to read and your body isn't co-operating.
