As an author, I hate to review a book with a negative response. I always try to find something positive about the book regardless of its content. I think, for the first time, I have been left dumbfounded and speechless.

First of all, the book is six pages long. Not very long at all. I saw this on Amazon and thought "What's the worst that could happen in six pages?"

Well, that's just it. Nothing happens. At times it felt like a poem that's been jumbled into incoherent sentences. Between paragraphs, the book has massive gaps. If you put them all together and relented on the tab and spacing, it would have filled two pages easily.

Then there's the blurb of a book. In fact, the Amazon description makes up 9% of the total Kindle viewing time. The grammar is poor (inexcusable in a published book), the sentences lazy and haphazard and, the kicker for me, the ABOUT THE AUTHOR page is nearly the same length as the entire 'story' itself.

Which is the final insult. It doesn't read like a story but more like a book pitch. One that doesn't do the story any favours. As a poem, and in the right hands, this could have been quite poignant but the fact is, it isn't. Sorry, but I've finally broken my one star review virginity. Read at your own risk.
