When I received the book, I was somewhat worried that it would be overly focused on the psychic abilities of the author. Psychic abilities are still items which I view with some skepticism and my views are not changed by this book. The author does not focus the work on these abilities nor is there any attempt to sway the reader into altering their perceptions or belief into the existence of clairvoyance or reincarnation.
