The Ruthers are a deranged, disgusting bunch of thugs ruled by a powerful matriarch figurehead. Their scams which involve drug dealing and prostitution hit an all time low when they are discovered to be behind a horrific sex trafficking plot involving underage girls from Russia. But not everyone is how they seem and the way main character Francesca Vincent gets involved exposes something far worse, something rooted in her own tragic past. The story is filled with twists with some harrowing and violent scenes but a very good read. I really liked some of the lesser characters too, such as Daisy and especially Tressa, a modern day Cinderella.

The story unravels beautifully from the start, but I have to say the final showdown scene felt a little rushed. I would have liked to have seen more build up in this part of the story too, especially with the judges and the way they were lured to the mansion; that final plot fell into place too quickly and easily for me.
