It is a scorching hot story of discovery with- elements of BDSM, Hot Alpha Males, suspense, angst and drama. The story is a showcase of the author's very proficient wordsmithing skills. Ms. Michelle has a captivating, sexy, bold and very descriptive style to her writing- which drew me in and held my attention from the very first page and the whole way through till the end.

He has a real estate development business that has had them travelling the world from New York to Munich, Paris to Los Angeles.
