I'm so conflicted with this book. I didn't particularly like First Impressions. But it was an introduction and the plot was kind of interesting. So I went all in with this one and **grrr**, I think I might develop split personalities from it?

Things that made me cringe:

- Eva decides on her own to date the three guys. I mean **she doesn't even ask** or anything. And they are so not ok with it. I'm here for the reverse harem but not if most of the characters are so against it. And she doesn't give them a choice about it.
- The unbalanced relationships. Reading reverse harem for more than a year now *-and most of my reads have been rh-* it is something that I really dislike. For me, if you want this kind of relationship all the characters involved need to be on an **equal footing**. This is clearly not the case here. Between the boys, Beckam feels left out in their relationship. And between Eva and the three, the fact that she keeps saying that Beckam feels like "home" makes the other boys stand down.
- They are never all together. In the first book, we weren't introduced to Beckam. This book Mason is mostly out. They **never hang out as a group** or have any kind of relationship (just being friendly) altogether.
- The over-abundance of supes? I don't know, when the secret is out of the bag now **everyone is something** and no one ever talked to Eva before about it or even about the fact that she is a supe too.

With that said, There are also things that I really liked and that makes me want to read the next book.

Things that I liked:

- **The flashbacks.** This was really well written. And a lot of times, I was reading a few paragraphs before realising it was a memory and not happening at the moment. So big thumbs up, because most of the time, this doesn't work on me and here I was totally hooked.
- Me playing a game of **What Eva and Beckam are?** In the beginning, I was frustrated with it, and then it was really like a game. Every time I would get an info, I would check in my mind with my knowledge about paranormal and take guesses. It's one of the main things that keeps me reading this series. Here my guessings for now, I'm really open to new suggestions though (view spoiler)
- The plot twist. I didn't see it coming and it was a real page-turner when it happened. (view spoiler)
- Some of the side characters. Like Shelton is a cutie even if we don't see him enough. And Tommy has potential. They are my *give great advice* characters.
