Once reluctant, she's now embracing her skills and assuming responsibility as the Seeker of Justice, in the witch world and the human world as well. She is unable to tell her beloved of her true nature, however, and this causes complications in the relationship. He falls under the influence of a succubus and things get even more complicated.

Stacy is struggling at the newspaper too. Her partner has hired a blonde bimbo sex columnist Stacy hates hates hates but can't do anything about because the bimbo's work is popular. Stacy is charged with keeping

an eye on the bimbo because she's either a bloodthirsty demon in slut clothing come to torment Stacy and her family, or needs protecting from the bloodthirsty demon. Stacy does enjoy tranquilizing the bimbo on a regular basis.

Samhain, the night when the veil between "them" and "us," is approaching and stranger-than-normal things are happening. A fairy with a sweet-tooth is stalking Stacy and a mysterious stranger shows up at the newspaper, knowing way more about Stacy than he ought to. Fulfilling her role as Seeker, and finding out how everything fits together may be harmful to Stacy's love life. Not figuring it all out may be harmful to Stacy's very existence, as well as that of the family she loves.

I started this on the elliptical at the gym the other day and that was the fastest 30 minutes I'd ever spent. I was so entranced with the story, I rushed through the rest of my workout so I could get home and keep reading.

All the recurring characters are back – Thor, Stacy's Great Dane "familiar"; Cinnamon, Stacy's cousin, pregnant and developing an uncharacteristic fondness for kitchen items with a fairytale theme; her wacky aunts; her beloved, Chance; and her ex-boyfriend the sheriff. The plot was captivating and the ending – wow, what a complete surprise.

While you could read these out of order, I recommend reading them in order for maximum enjoyment.
