

Well this was not what I was expecting at all! Not in a bad way though. The first book in the series revolved around Carey's slightly older twin Casey and was a lighthearted romance with a little action/suspense thrown in. This book is the other way around and much grittier. There is some violence and it's a bit more graphic than I like in an audio book as you can't skim past it. Not really a stand-a-lone.

After Casey and his new wife depart on their honeymoon, Carey must take more of a leadership role in the cattle drive. The city slickers who paid to come with are a mixed bag of personalities. One in particular though, Amy, takes Carey's interest. Then word comes that the town pimp and drug pusher has attacked the homestead and Carey leaves to help them out. Amy offers to join him and this turns out to be a good thing, because there's more to Amy than the quiet woman who lacks self confidence. In fact there's a good reason she had lost her confidence and the action in this book will help restore her to her old self (and bring her and Carey closer together of course!). I was kinda worried at first that she was going to be a wimpy h...

I was expecting the suspense to be as simplistic as the last book, but it wasn't and really kept me on my toes. It's not non-stop though, being interspersed with vignettes with other characters. I never felt that the story wasn't foremost about Carey and Amy though.

There's a sweet little bit where Casey and Amanda are on their honeymoon.

Although the ending is an HEA, it was a wee bit HFN too, leading to the third book, as far as intrigue is concerned. But there's no annoying set up for the next love interests in this book which I am vastly thankful for, and makes me really want to get the next story!!

I loved reading Searching For Love (Contemporary Cowboy Romance) (Carson Hill Ranch series: Book 2), all about Carey Carson the second oldest twin & Amy a cop from Detroit who goes on the cattle drive that the Carson Ranch runs two or three times a year. Amy is considered a city newbie and is treated differently than the Cowboys and the men on the cattle drive. This is a romantic story about Amy and Carey. It is the second in the series. I had not read the first book, and feel it would have enhanced my enjoyment had I done that. The first book obviously covers the story of Carey's brother and Miranda. In this book, Miranda alludes to events and actions that occurred in the first book, and, not having read it, I was at a loss to really understand. If the author wishes this to be a stand-alone book, I recommend she include a couple of sentences about the events from the first book, at least the first time the event/action is alluded to. This really wouldn't add all that much to the book length but would make the book more understandable and enjoyable. The book is not very long and includes several different plots/subplots. Since there are so many and since the book is not very long, there is little time to fully develop any of these plots/subplots. As I read the book, I felt the author was rushed to get the information out for the plots/subplots. There was no time for development of any. I think it would have been better to have less plots/subplots, so there could be more development of those that are present. I thought there was no

chemistry between Carey and Amy. They just sort of met and fell right into “love”, with little or no lead-in. I would have preferred more development. In addition, with so many different plots/subplots, the author has little time to develop any of the characters. Thus, they all come across as superficial and shallow. Less plots/subplots would have eliminated this. In addition, the author could have written a longer book, if she wanted to have this many plots/subplots. The basic storyline is quite a good one and shows lots of promise. I thought the fact that all this occurred during a tourist participation in a cattle drive was novel and interesting. However, again, a lot of the story did not take place on the drive, and I never really did get any sort of a feel for the drive or any of the participants. There was just too much the author was covering to give her the opportunity to cover anything adequately. I had difficulty deciding how to grade this book for all these reasons. I finally decided on a three star rating because of the good points I mentioned and because of the lack of depth. I think anyone who enjoyed the first book or other of the author’s books would enjoy this one. I received this from Library Thing to read and provide an honest review.
