I am calling it now (though it doesn't take a genius to figure it out), Kit will probably end up healing each of the guys in the group at some point and they will all be able to turn into their given tattoos. I can't wait! Though, I am unsure if River already has the ability or not since it has been strongly hinted that he does.

As far as our newest harem member goes... I'm not complaining. I really liked Vali and I knew from the second he came on the page that he wasn't evil. I think he will spice things up a little between the other harem members and I am all here for it.

Not often can an author shock me anymore with plot twists, but I will say that Tate James shocked me to my core in this book.
