The author should really consider changing the cover on the next round of printing on this book to something that better reflects the plotline.

This book is part mystery, part romance set in Sweden. I really enjoyed the author's attempt at sharing Swedish culture and language, and while I thought it was a good page turner, I was a little disappointed there was no big twists or turns in the plot.

Hopefully there were not too many copies of this book printed, as it really needs a good editor to comb through all the typos. I also found the epilogue unnecessarily verbose; it shouldn't take 30 pages to let you know where the three main characters end up after the climax of the story.

i did get a bit lost halfway through, and at times confused with the characters. Also, the cover is quite misleading, as it isn't some sort of sex book, but more of a suspenseful mystery-adventure kind of novel, with romance incorporated into it as well. The epilogue was also a bit long and i thought somewhat unnecessary, and so i skimmed the last few pages. One thing that drove me CRAZY was the continuous misspelling of the word 'quiet' which was always spelled as 'quite'. It drove me nuts, as it appeared frequently. That, and a few small grammatical errors, were the only issues i had with the writing. I really like Anderson's style of writing, and her development of characters, which i felt was very sustained and well-thought out (as many novels have characters that all of a sudden change dramatically) Overall, a good read :)
