Okay, I said I wasn't going to read any Christmas books until November. Call me lazy, but I wanted something to read on my phone so I didn't have to put the light on and disturb DH and this was the first thing that caught my eye.

This is a pretty classic reunion trope, with heiress Stella Jackson going back to England to her grandfather's estate to fulfil a vow to spend a month there before deciding whether to sell. Only trouble is that Evan Foss, the boy who rejected her so humiliatingly four years ago is going to be there. He's been maintaining the property since Nicholas Jackson died and wants to buy it.

Evan came from a tough background and owes everything to Nicholas so young Stella was technically off limits for a guy who didn't believe in love and commitment.

Stella has some hangups too, caused by her selfish mother and her ex-fiance. And especially Evan. It's his rejection that really impacted and she is definitely not going to trust a guy who was obviously all about himself.

The progression of the romance, that includes lots of smexytimes is pretty predictable, but is told in a very engaging way, allowing us to watch the layers being peeled from both lonely Stella and closed off Evan.

There was a twist that you kind of guessed was coming without knowing what it was. The end was touching. I did get a tear but as it was not about the romance, it didn't push up the score.

Millionaire Under Mistletoe is my first time reading a book by this author but I really enjoyed it (and actually even thought the author was English/British with how accurate she captured the settings and tones of the characters). This is a second chance Christmas romance an Australian woman and a sexy Englishman whose lives have been intertwined for years since they met when younger. The book also includes a bet theme between the two characters which twists the book even further.

Told from dual points of views, Evan and Stella have such an incredible attraction right from the moment they meet up again, even if they try to hide it given the motives that are leading these two back to each other. Both characters were likeable and strong, but vulnerable too, and what starts off as a temporary romance soon turns into more as they grow closer and things heat up in the bedroom. Evan has such a soft side underneath his tough exterior, as does Stella, which is what makes these two perfect for each other as they find security, love and happiness in each other after failing to fully experience that in their pasts.

Millionaire Under Mistletoe is a well written Christmas themed romance that is perfect to read especially at this time of year (coming up to Winter). The book is fairly fast paced as it takes place over only a couple of weeks but given the history the two share, it worked well. This is a second chance romance involving a wealthy heiress and the self-made millionaire she knew as a teenager. She was brought up in Australia but her roots are back in England. When her paternal grandfather was dying, she promised to spend a month in his home which she inherited from him. She'd spent summers there when she was growing up and has happy memories of the people and place. She also has memories of being rejected by Evan Ross, someone whose Mum worked on the estate and who her grandfather mentored and guided. Now Evan wants to buy the estate from her but his rejection of her when she was eighteen really upset her, especially as she'd had a secret crush on him for years and felt isolated, unable to relate to her peers and rejected by her mother. Now she's had additional relationship difficulties and is determined to

protect her heart from further pain but will either of them be able to ignore the attraction between them? Will their pasts prevent them giving love a chance?

This story is set in England during December. The characters are well developed with very different but still traumatic pasts which influence their relationships with others dramatically. There are some great secondary characters - especially Matt and Ethel (and no, they aren't a couple!) It is an enjoyable second chance romance in a festive English countryside and London.

He requested that she go back and spend one month there, one final Christmas before selling it, if that's what she decides to do. That's exactly what she'd going to do; she lives in Australia and has no intention of giving up her warm weather and early morning surfing for cold, rainy, dreary London.

Evan Foss is on his way to the same estate. He grew up there, Stella's grandfather acting as a surrogate grandfather to Evan, and now he needs to convince Stella that he's the right buyer for the estate.

Stella may resent having to be in London for Christmas instead of surfing, but I can't deny I find the prospect of heading to London extremely enticing right now. So I had a little trouble drumming up as much sympathy for her as I would usually have. But that's my own issue. This book was all the things I love most in Stefanie London's books. It was sweet and charming, but there's are underlying deeper themes being explored and more to Stella and Evan than is immediately apparent. They have a history, having grown up together on the estate and it informs every one of their interactions. Stella has some issues she's been trying to work through, and being thrown back into her childhood home with her childhood crush is bringing them all back up to the surface.

Evan's been fighting his own demons, and he thinks that getting this estate will be the final piece to realizing his dreams and finally being the man he's always wanted and the man Stella's grandfather thought he could be and wanted him to be. To that end, he's willing to do whatever it takes to convince Stella to sell it to him.

Neither of them have the time or interest in a relationship, especially one with so much pre-existing baggage, and double especially not with someone who lives so many time zones away. But, as we knew would happen, fate has other plans, and they find themselves very much embroiled in what is, by all appearances, a relationship.

Stefanie London has once again created a charming, sweet story that sucked me in right away. There was obviously a little more to everything than what the surface showed, and I really enjoyed finding out everyone's secrets. I had a little trouble warming up to both Evan and Stella, but I got there eventually. And, frankly, I'm not going to put that on Stefanie London because this week was a pretty big shitshow here in the U.S. and everything has been discombobulated and topsy-turvy and nothing was as it should be. I have no way to know if I would have felt that way under other circumstances, so I'm not blaming her for something that may not even exist.

Bottom line - if you're looking to up your holiday romance quotient, if you need a fun, charming story to help you escape the garbage fire we're all currently dealing with, if you're just looking for a good book, pick this one up.
