I wanted to like it, I've read 2 other books by the author which I liked very much. I had it on my wish list for months because it was a little pricy for an ebook but I finally bought it.

Sam is a very successful erotic romance author who's dreamed of a man since she was 14 years old. She hired an artist, made him her cover man and named him Chance Davis. David Chance (a professional wrestler) is the living image of Sam's dream man. When he discovers Sam's novels he's shocked. Not only did she steal his image, but the character as written IS him. So off he goes to confront Sam at a book signing.

I thought the premise sounded interesting but implausible. So I told myself to suspend belief and go with it. I tried, but sadly, the story never lived up to its potential. SPOILER ALERT: What didn't work for me:

The dream plot wasn't explained and only mentioned in passing for the rest of the book. Then it turned into "be my sex toy for six months and I won't sue you and your publisher".

The characters were undeveloped and behaved inconsistently. Especially Sam, one minute she's falling on him ripping his clothes off the next she's indignant or insecure.

Not much backstory for them and then in the middle of the book the author threw out a huge surprise about Sam which I thought needed more explanation considering what had come before but when it was disclosed to David he just took it in stride.

These characters never had real conversations. They kept up the inner dialogue and the big misunderstanding could have been solved by one of them speaking their mind. They only connected through sex, and hey, I love me some smutty, frequent sex in my books but I want to feel the emotions too.

The wrestling scenes were distracting and the secondary characters could have been left out and not missed.

The ending was abrupt.

David Chance is a pro wrestler; imagine his shock when his agent tells him he is the face on the cover of not one but numerous romance novels. Best sellers at that.
