This was a very intriguing shifter story that I enjoyed reading, and it had a few exciting twists and turns to keep my interest piqued. Rachel is an amateur model; the work is hard, but it is something she loves doing. Persuaded to attend a party, she meets Shawn, who is not only a dragon shifter but an assassin. Shawn makes Rachel feel safe and wanted all at the same time, but Shawn makes it clear they will never meet again; loving and marrying a human was out of the question for him – it wasn't allowed. It is no coincidence that Shawn is at that party, but he leaves Rachel with more than she bargained for, and even though she tries to track Shawn down it is to no avail. Rachel wants to return to her modelling career, but Justin, her new agent, expects unreasonable “favours” from her, which are not acceptable, but he suffers the consequences when he directs his anger at Rachel. The sighting of another dragon shifter brings Shawn back into contact with Rachel, but danger follows them and they have to outwit an enemy; Rachel is always able to tell when danger is near and this knowledge proves invaluable on many occasions. A failed mission puts Shawn's life, and those of his friends, in danger when he is relentlessly pursued by a Phoenix, who is intent on fighting

him. Shawn is devastated when he thinks he has lost his friends and acquaintances in Sub-Dublin, and falls into a state of regret and despair. But fate has not forgotten him and he is finally able to fulfil his destiny. An interesting and diversified story that was an engaging read.
