Juliet doesn't like hot weather or sunny beaches. She'd much prefer the colder climates, thank you. Which is why she always volunteers for the Alaska trip when her job needs someone to take some readings there. She's pretty much forgotten about her accidental meeting with Gerri Wilder. Just because the woman found mates for Juliet's best friend doesn't mean there's a shifter mate out there for her. She really wasn't expecting what she found on the mountain while she was there, though.

Tevrik has been in a self-imposed exile from his pack since a tragedy had him running 15 years ago. Even after all this time he still hasn't forgiven himself & some of the clan he runs into let him know that they haven't forgotten either. He certainly doesn't deserve a mate & doesn't believe the matchmaker when she says his mate will drop into his lap. I have to say, Winter Takes All is my FAVORITE of the PDA books so far. In a different twist, there is actually turmoil on the shifter side in this book. Tevrik, an artic white wolf shifter, is the true mate to Juliet, a human geologist studying snow levels in Alaska. They have both had contact with, directly and indirectly, Gerri Wilder, and she once again knows exactly what they both need. They meet as a result of an avalanche, and Tevrik is tasked with caring for Juliet. Hijinks and swoon-worthy moments ensue, but the build up is so different than other PDA books. Usually, the shifter accepts things immediately and sexy times ensue quickly. However, without revealing too much and spoiling the fun, Tevrik is resistant to the relationship.
