Well written and edited stand-alone book with minor editing issues. More like a 3.5 stars, but I rounded up.

This story has some Beauty and the Beast elements, along with Cinderella, but this couple's story is more complicated, since both characters have some emotional damage and trust issues to overcome. It's definitely a fairy tale love story, set in Canada. . . with a side trip to Bora Bora.

The main female character lacks self-confidence, but isn't a pushover. The main male character lacks personal self-confidence and is gruff and rude. The butler acts as a fairy godmother character for both of them, orchestrating a marriage of convenience, sight unseen. As unbelievable as that is, the heat that develops between these two characters did seem entirely believable.

The wicked step-sisters are played by his hideous brother, father and an ex-girlfriend. There's an emotional crisis, but as with all fairy tales, in the end, a satisfying happily-ever-after.
