### Chapter 2: What We Teach (each section has a helpful ages/stages box)

1. Working: commission > allowance; teach kids the connection between working and making money; age-appropriate chores (very helpful); some chores should be unpaid—just part of being in the family; 3–5yos respond well to instant gratification (immediate payment for chores), but transition to a weekly commission as they get older (6+)
2. Spending: this is a skill; parents still control this; 6+ can pay for things at the fair, etc.
3. Saving: this keeps people out of debt
4. Giving: tithing at church; can give items too (clothing, toys)
5. Debt: becoming wealthy by avoiding debt; pay with cash
