Rick isn't a smooth talking, well liked PI. He doesn't always save the day. He's smart, with good instincts, though, they don't always get him to his target in time. He's stuck between the Russian mafia on one case, and a deadly serious stalker on another. He doesn't have many friends or law enforcement contacts. He has to take the fight to the bad guys, before they get to him. This is in a league of its own.

Naomi at Night - in San Diego; a soothing voice on the radio from 9PM till studio. Rick Cahill was called by Chip Evigan to that station because he believed that Naomi had been threatened. A six page letter was shown by Chip to Rick (a PI) who was hired to work out the case. The threat became a possible truth, "Don't disappoint me and awaken my rage." This, if Naomi did not mention "Pluto" by name on her broadcast once in the following week. She was told nothing of any threat or letter. This, likely, due to the station wanting her to sign her new contract? Chip wanted to flush out this Pluto - but no cops and everything had to be on the QT.

Eventually, after Naomi's show that evening, Rick went with Naomi to a bar where he showed her a copy of the letter. She does not think it is a credible threat. Later, she calls Rick to tell him that someone stole her gun! He went to her house to find out what was going on.

No gun permit so she insists - no cops. He asked her when she did time in prison. She runs to her room and

slams the door. Rick stands vigil the whole night. During that time, Rick checks Naomi out on the internet and finds that she has a clean record. This is when the reader wonders if Naomi is REALLY Naomi.

The following morning, Naomi tells Rick about her background. she was in an arranged married when she was 14 - the groom was 25!

Just when you think all of the plot is in front of you; the Russian Mafia are involved, Naomi gets a bodyguard, Rick is sent on a nightly mission, Rick gets in trouble with the cops and FBI, Alicia (who worked at Sonic drive-thru) disappears, Rick's friend Moira is in the picture and everything goes upside down. We find out that Rick owes the Russians a favor (and 10,000) and a nightly stake out. Also they bring in some stem cell research and a trip to a Gentlemen's Club.

Just when you think that TOO MUCH has been folded into the story, pieces fall together and with a number of twists and turns, you cannot put the book down'
