I just discovered these little Harlequin online novellas, so this is the first I read. I think it's lightly attached to a series, but can be read by itself. Here, a prince and CEO of a company has been carrying on an affair with an employee and is ready to ask her to marry him. They get down to the bottom of it and resolve things - technically she wasn't blackmailed into his bed, as it was her idea...it was more of a deal. It was nice to see a hero who was able to take a step back and look more objectively at the "betrayal" and come to forgive the heroine because of this. This was a pretty good story - a bit short, but very complete.
