I cannot imagine such torment in one's heart when their aspire tells them to go away, let alone couldn't remember them. Albeit you're a new character, I can feel your pure love for Russell (I didn't see this coming but am so happy that you came!!!!). So fine, I shall let Russell live in this novel just for you. Wow! I loved this book. So. Much. Action! Awesome, awesome, awesome!

Things are getting even more crazy for Evie and her friends and it's hard to be non spoilery about earlier books in the series, so read this at your own risk.

This book begins with Evie, Reed, Russell, Zee, Brownie and Buns all together again and once again preparing for danger. I love this group together! They play off each other brilliantly, and they truly have become a family. They tease and banter, and they work together so well. And then danger comes and all hell breaks loose. It's action-packed and so exciting, and with Evie and Russell both coming in to their power now (I'm loving watching them develop), there are some fantastic supernatural powers at play which make it even better. Old players are back, determined to get their hands on Evie, and in the middle of all of the mayhem, new characters are introduced which add another layer of complexity to the story. And through it all, the family stand strong, fighting for their very lives, and the lives of the ones that they love.

It's a rollercoaster ride, with surprise after surprised dropped, and I feel like I barely took a breath while it was all going on. I listened to this as an audiobook and had it playing at every opportunity, desperate for more, and not wanting it to end. Bartol does a great job balancing the love story. Incendiary starts out right where we left off in Indebted, with Evie and Russell training with the other angels on Zee's island. Incendiary welcomed several new characters to the series that I loved, and boy did they ever shake things up!! This book is as great as the 3rd one, *Indebted*. There were breathtaking surprises at every twist in the story and nothing was expected **at all**. Basically, the plot still focused on Evie, or Genevieve Ava Claremont, the "half-breed" with Seraphim (a high rank angel) and human blood in her veins. Since the day she was ~~born~~ created, both angels from Heaven and demons from Sheol/Hell had been searching for her consistently because she was the only angel that possessed a pure soul. That is, she was inevitably stuck with ~~lots of men~~ many guys, including her *aspire* Reed, her *soul mate* Russell, her long-time...~~boyfriend~~ (of course, she didn't remember anything before the current lifetime) *guardian angel* Xavier, and her *futuristic king* (I hope not!) Brennus.

Although this wasn't exactly a love-**pentagon** (because she already chose her "aspire" and bonded with him), she still seemed to be attractive to and irresistible when it came to those other guys.
