Many mercenaries freelanced, but under talented freebooting leaders some groups became crack outfits. South Africa's Executive Outcomes became a legend in its own time like a quasi military itself, as it dispatched fighters throughout the continent. Like an ad hoc Foreign Legion, fighters came from all countries around the globe to participate in the combats. In the US, the publisher of Soldier of Fortune magazine organized repeated expeditions from Laos to Peru. In Afghanistan the renowned helicopter gunship pilot Nellis has recently lent his skills after almost singlehandedly defeating gruesome insurgencies in Africa. In this book Al Venter, who was actively involved in the direction and production of segments of the TV series "Mercenaries", provides both background to this unique class of warriors, and a fascinating look at their methods and actions."
