Oddest of all, she swears she sees a man watching her from the woods while in class. Nathan, Heather, Sean, and Olivia are like Chloe. Their lives all changed when they turned eighteen. From them Chloe learns that they all have special powers and are descendants from the Originals. She is the Chosen and possess powers of the elements. Nathan can hear other people's thoughts. Heather can bind the will of those around her. Sean can turn into any animal and Olivia can see their future. Firstly, I liked this cover--so dark and mysterious. And the book starts out the same way. . .well, not so dark but definitely mysterious. Chloe has her 18th birthday, but since her best friend is gone, isn't totally excited about it. But she doesn't have too much time to grumble because everything is about to go weird. When she looks in the mirror, she seems different. She's not sure how to explain it, but something about her has changed. At school, everyone is staring at her, especially the group of 'in' people can't seem to take their eyes off of her--totally strange for a girl who basically hid in the shadows most of her life.

And the story takes off from there. There's adventure (tons of adventure), handsome men (*aehm* hot ones with amazing powers) and bonds of friendship. Even when she's sleeping, Chloe is haunted by evil forces, which test her new powers to the limit. The added mystery of who or what this evil force is makes the entire

thing even better. I found it a little unrealistic that her new group of friends so readily accepted her as their leader (even if they knew it before, they are human teenagers), but really appreciated their extreme devotion.

The fight scenes are brutal, and Chloe comes away with more than a few scrapes or bruises. Despite her amazing super powers, she always seems fairly easy bait for Mr. Evil (I'm just calling him that) to attack. I really wished the heavens would have zapped her down a little more help because despite her hot boyfriends ability to always come to her rescue, I still wanted her to give the evil guy at least one really, really good punch in the nose. Yes, I got into this book and rooted for Chloe and her friends the entire way through until the wee-hours of the morning.

As for the romance side, love those hot heroes! Her dark, mysterious savior was amazing and simply enjoyable to have around. Another hero is thrown in half-way through, Chloe's Protector.
