With each book you get a look into the lives of different characters, but they all tie in together and Kaitriana (the Chosen) is always at there as the Queen of Queens. Forsaken was fast paced with some very steamy romance scenes and a lot of intrigue.

Ella isn't your ordinary 26 year old, she is a witch and has been living in the human world most of her life. Her Mother was killed when she was younger and they were living in the Realm and Ella has no idea who her Father is. After her Mother dies Ella moves back to the human world. Grieving and trying to survive, Ella studies and works to make a life for herself. On celebrating the end of her studies, she goes out with friends for some drinks and fun. Sitting at the bar, Cole walks up and Ella knows immediately he is a vampire and a Dark. Cole is determined to get into her good graces with Ella and help her home (since she couldn't make it by herself). After succumbing to Cole's charms and their instant attraction, Ella allows Cole to take her home and inside her apartment. Knowing it is dangerous, but also wanting a little action, Cole

drives Ella mad with pleasure.

Cole (known in the Realm as Nicholas) has been watching Ella since she was a child. Knowing she is special and hoping to get Ella to want him and desire him, Cole is determined to leave Ella wanting him at every visit. He isn't divulging all of his life to her and known in the Realm as the Warrior of Dark, he is the fiercest and most feared vampire in the Dark legion.

The war between Light and Dark is coming to a head with the Chosen and the Warrior of Light attacking the Dark. Nicholas is called back to the Realm and Ella is taken into the Light coven. Kaitriana is helping Ella bring her powers to the surface and discover how much power she possesses.

All the time that Cole/Nicholas spent with Ella in the human world and he cannot stop thinking about her. They have discovered feelings for each other that shouldn't have grown. But can they be together, since they both come from opposite sides of the Realm? Will their love conquer? Can Cole/Nicholas or Ella convert to the other side? Who is Ella's Father? Will Light prevail?

I really love this series and can't wait for Broken. It is unique with witches, vampires and magic, plus the good versus evil war, but what is unique is the story and prophesy that still needs to be fulfilled. I'm not sure what to say about this book. I wasn't sure I wanted to continue the series after the first one (Chosen). I read Forsaken to see if it got better. It didn't, yet I'm going to continue. I really like Fleener's writing, but the stories in books 1 and 2 were ... how do I say it? I had to step away several times because I was getting so frustrated.

First off, "Forsaken" is essentially "Chosen" in plot and purpose. The male leads are A-holes, that treat their soul-mates as submissives, like Billionaire BDSMers, without the S&M. Cole basically sexually assaults Ella for the first 100 pages. He's affiliated with the Dark, she says "no", he ignores her, she succumbs to his sexual manipulations. I really wanted to like Ella, but she turned in Ella-sue so quickly. If it wasn't for the last 50-pages I'd drop the books. I like Fleener's writing, and the premise for book-3 looks promising.

Second issue, the primary "Dark/Evil" antagonists seem completely unworthy. Cardboard characters, and too easily thwarted.

Third, all the females characters are too easily distracted/controlled by their desires. Christ, the antagonists are fighting with the wrong tools. Take off your shirt, drop trough and win the frickin war.

Which leads to my biggest gripe ... other then the rising of the queens and the good versus evil crap, I see no underlying plot. The two main characters spend the first third of the book in bed (quite literally), then they venture out, kick ass way to easily (with little development or fan fare), separate and then come back together. The Kings series by Walden and the Carpathian series by Feehan are done better then the Ancients of Light, but I like Fleener's writing, so I'm going to hold out for one more.

The first 17 chapters are set primarily in Chicago where you meet Ella, a non-practicing Fire Caste witch with a fiery personality and Nicholas (aka Cole), a dark vampire warrior. The storyline slows down a little in the middle of this first part as the romance heats up. This section reminded me a little bit of *Pretty Woman* minus the stripper.

The following 30 chapters are mostly set in the Realm. Ella and Nicholas' story becomes intertwined with Lorcan and Kaitriana. This is where I had trouble putting the book down until I finished it.

I must confess I am getting a little addicted to this series. When I read the first book I didn't realize these were paranormal romance novels so I was a little taken back by the "romance" aspect. I am not a huge romance novel reader, but this is one of the best ones I have read. **I usually associate romance novel with not having much of a storyline outside the romance, but this book is so much more than just your typical romance.**

It was a great read once I got past being uncomfortable with certain details. It is a constant battle between Dark and Light with much romance mixed into the already fragile condition of the Realm. I look forward to the next installment of the ANCIENTS OF LIGHT Series to see the rise of all the Queens and find out which side will prevail.

You see, the Vampire created for a Dark purpose, while the Witch was created to counteract that Darkness with Light. The Witch's purpose was to destroy the evil wreaking havoc on mankind, known as the Vampire. However, in CHOSEN Book#1, Vampire and Witch ally to serve the Light together against the Dark. For just being a Vampire or Witch no longer determines your allegiance, both sides have been aligned with both creatures. Now a war is raging for one side to end the other for all time. But who will win? According to a prophecy long foretold, the Queens will rise to give strength to the Light that will overcome the Dark.

Ella never felt much of a connection to her Fire Caste due to the fact they shunned her mother for not divulging who Ella's father was. This causes her mother to raise her in the world outside of the Realm until her powers develop to the point of no longer being able to be concealed from humans. Though her mother returns her to the Realm for her safety, Ella leaves to start her own life outside the Realm as soon as her mother dies and she is of age. She pours her heart and soul into school, work and her friends. Though she enjoys flirting when out with her friends, she has little time or desire to commit to any guy. That is, until she meets Cole. She senses he is a Dark Vampire, but she cannot stop herself from entertaining his advancements. She is captivated by him.
