She decides that, to rekindle their marriage, she has to get him away from Suzy. Never revealing that she knew about his infidelity, she convinces him to buy a house far from his workplace. In that new neighborhood, while fitting her new torsolette, exposed from the waist below, she spots a man from next-door looking at her. For some reason, he makes her feel desired and beautiful. Hungry for those blissful feelings that her husband has been robbing her of, she turns to the strange, old man, eager to please him. But is being watched enough? Will they cross the boundaries of their own homes?

Before I jump into the erotic parts of this book, I would like to commend Abby Weeks for making Janey opt for the more discreet option of keeping her discovery of his infidelity a secret and trying to fix their marriage from within and not take the fight outside the boundaries of their home to his mistress. It definitely sets a mature tone for the story. It also makes it realistic, because as opposed to what some women say that they will fight for their husbands, cause scenes, destroy mistresses, etc., sometimes, it really just downplays into being afraid to shake up and ruined the marriage over-all.

Now, for the steamy scenes... Voyeurism does seem like an interesting theme for this book, because it sets the border between cheating and not cheating for Janey. It works and every sexual performance by Janey is memorable, and in a way, empowering. Her sexual awakening took me aback when the quick transition happened, but in the end, it was just surreal...and inspiring.
