This one, though slightly over 150 pages long, packed great intensity, chemistry, and connection between the Dom and the sub. Each pairing must explore all items on the BDSM checklist, under that particular letter, that both have marked with interest. Mae and Xavier are total opposites - sweet, soft, and bratty versus hard, demanding, and unyielding. Both are taken aback by the pairing. Xavier tests Mae's limits with the harder side of BDSM, and, in the process, uncovers surprising truths about both of them.
